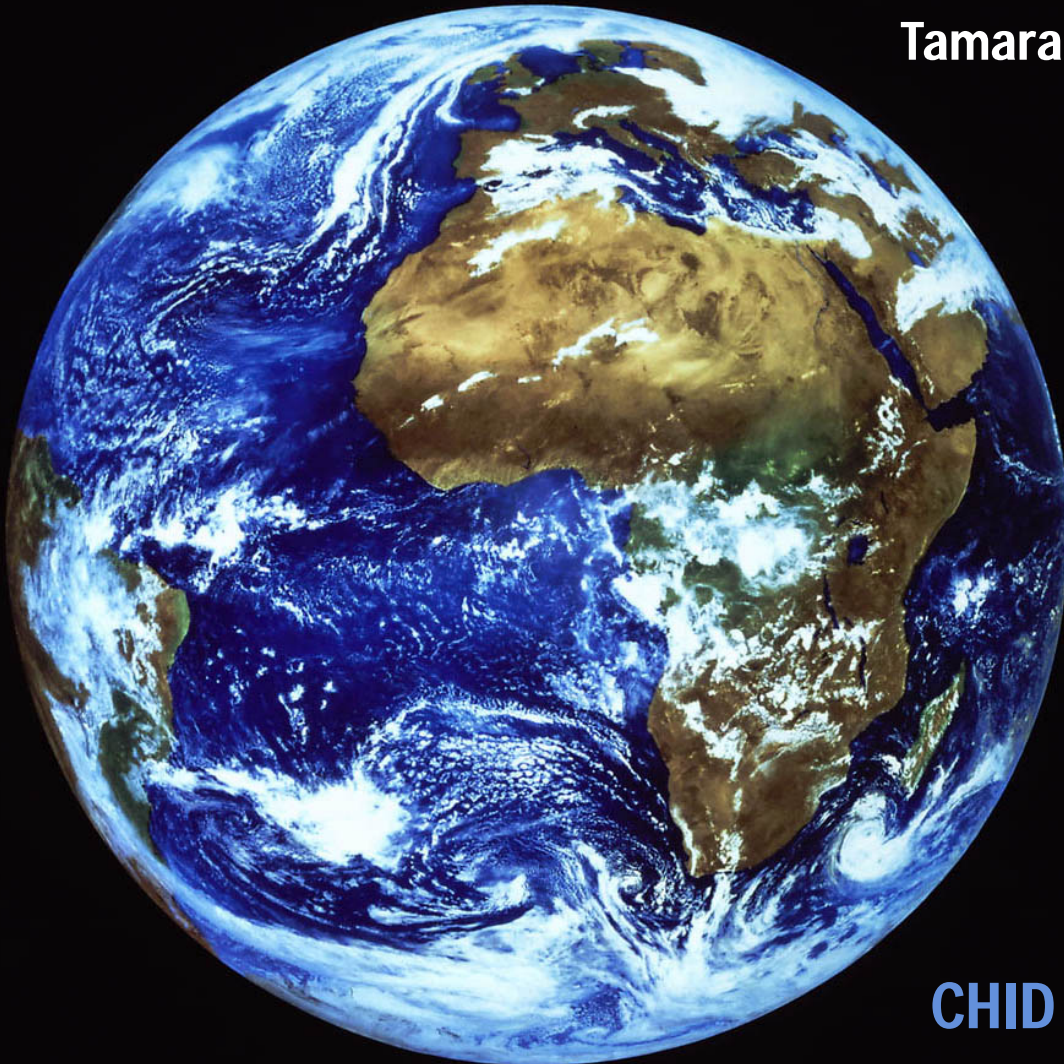


Rethinking Diversity
